- Have you lost income because of the pandemic and employer closures?
- Are you behind in rent or worried about being evicted?
- Do you know if you are protected by eviction moratoriums?
- Are you worried your landlord may lock you out?
- Do you want to negotiate with your landlord to keep your home, but you don't know where to start?

The Chicago City Council passed a historic Ordinance to mandate landlords negotiate with tenants before filing evictions!

We are here to help meet this goal.

Lawyers' Committee for Better Housing has FREE attorneys who will give you advice, negotiate with your landlord, or even represent you in court if you are a Chicagoan who is at risk of being evicted because of the COVID-19 pandemic.

- We have social workers who will help determine whether you are eligible for emergency rental assistance.
- We have Spanish-speaking staff and can obtain interpreters in any language.
